Aloha Community Members,

We want to provide an update regarding HULA's Spring League and other Ultimate-related activities in light of recent developments regarding the Coronavirus (COVID-19) outbreak. Mayor Caldwell recently [announced](#) that all city parks are closed through April 30, 2020. He also [mandated](#) an emergency "stay at home" order for all of Oahu effective March 23, 2020 through the end of April. It has become clear that to keep the public safe we must do our [part to mitigate the spread of Coronavirus](#).

Therefore, due to these local government directives, HULA has extended its suspension of Spring League through April 30, 2020. During that time, HULA also strongly cautions against attending practices, ultimate clinics, or pick-up games.

Why not just cancel Spring League and be done with it?

Following the lead of other Ultimate organizations around the nation, we decided to defer cancelling Spring League in its entirety for the time being. When the parks reopen, the league commissioners will work to see if we can obtain additional field space, revise the schedule, or offer a pro-rated registration fee for an abbreviated season. **However, we understand that this situation is unprecedented and our community members may be facing a variety of hardships in this difficult time. HULA recognizes that this may come as upsetting news in a time when normalcy has been put on hold. We will continue to closely monitor the guidelines from the CDC, the Hawaii Department of Health, and local government.
